MATE - South Africa Partnership

Below is the communal garden in the village of Mazotsho – which is on the southern shore of the Binfield Dam – the water supply for the Tyhume Valley.



The Mazotsho Home Garden Committee is responsible for this garden:

- 24 total members; 21 are women.
- Of the 21 women, 16 are widows.
- Average age is 59; only 14 receive a pension.
- These 24 families support 115 total people; 33 are AIDS orphans.
- The 14 pensioners receive R1,080 per month old age pension, about \$135. None have jobs – there are very few jobs.
- Total family income is less than \$1 per day per person.
