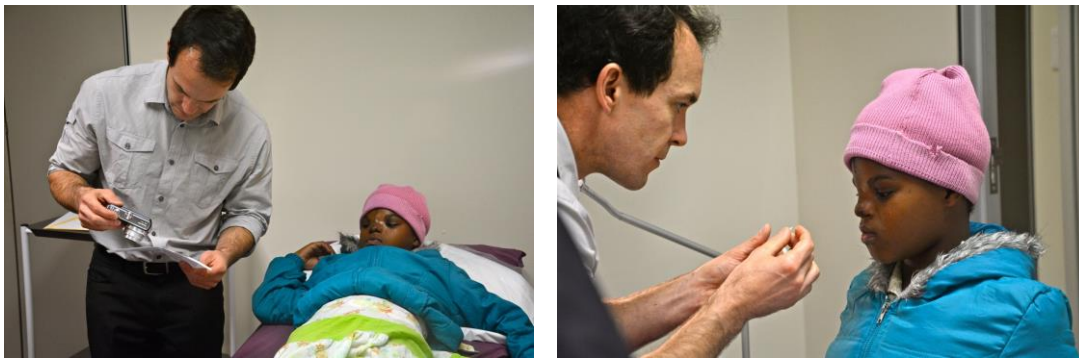
Dear All

Just a quick update to let you know that Zandile and family are all well.

On Weds 20th August I took Zandile with her mother and father to the Life Hospital in East London.



When there, Dr Kepler removed her stitches and checked on the wound and scar before reapplying tape, which needed to stay on for another week or so while the wound continued healing.



He was extremely pleased with how her nose is looking, as are the rest of us, mostly Zandile!



We then crossed the hospital hallway to the Laser Clinic. There Zandile and her mother were talked through the process about to take place, and underwent her 1st round of Laser Treatment for the hairline on her forehead. It gave Zandile a bit of a fright, but only lasted for a few seconds!



Our next laser treatment appointment is on 1st October. She will need up to 12 treatments in total, approximately once a month. The hugest of thanks to Dr Kepler once again for arranging this!

I then took the family out for lunch, and returned them home.



I then received a call from Zandile's teacher at Hopefield Primary School on Monday 25th August, inviting me to a prayer service they would be holding in the school hall on Wednesday 27th at 9am – to thank everyone involved in helping Zandile on her journey.
